This 9 -hour course is designed for students entering grades 9 - 12 who want to get better grades in less time by learning the habits used by successful students.

Participants will:

- Identify “How Am I Smart?”
- Learn to prioritize and plan.
- Learn to organize papers.
- Learn to read a textbook.
- Learn how to take notes.

Today’s students are generally unequipped to process, manage, prioritize, and learn the massive amounts of information they encounter.

In a small group setting (no more than six students) with a trained and experienced teacher and coach, participating students will be immersed in the SOAR Study Skills Curriculum.

The fee includes a digital application for students to extend learning and practice skills during and beyond this course, as well as a planner.

Prerequisites:

An open mind and willingness to work. Students who succeed in this short course participate by choice.

Summer Session 2: M-F, 8/7/23 3pm – 4:30pm

(7.5 hours total plus one 90-minute follow-up session in the fall. Total time = 9 hours).

Cost: \$460.00 (Fee includes unlimited access during and beyond the course to the SOAR learning app. Fee also includes a 90-minute follow up session in September (TBD) to review, trouble shoot, & answer questions). *This fee is due with registration prior to the first day of the course.*
